FIRST AID

Perform a jar test to check compatibility with other products prior to mixing.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Add 1/3 water or fertilizer to spray tank with agitation.
2. Add required amount of Marco Iron Plus.
3. Add any other pesticide to the tank.
4. Fill tank with balance of water or fertilizer while maintaining agitation.
5. Agitate adequately for uniformity of solution before applying.

RECOMMENDED RATES

Row or Band: 1 to 2 quarts per acre before or at planting
Broadcast: 2 to 2.5 quarts per acre mixed into the top few inches of soil

Foliar: 1 to 2 pints per acre

Lower rates should be used on field, row, or vegetable crops. Higher rates should be used for fruit, nut, and vine crops. When rates of over 2 quarts are called for, split or multiple applications of the total amount needed are preferred. Applications should be separated by a minimum of 10–14 days.

Aerial Application: 1 to 2 pints per acre in 5 gallons of water per application

Drip Application: Apply the required amount over the growing season via multiple applications spaced 1 to 2 weeks apart.
